The UK produces a total of 414 million tonnes of waste each year and six percent of this is household waste. In one day, the average British family produces 1.74 Kg of waste.

In one year, this amount of rubbish is equal to the weight of 11 adults! Of this, only 7% is recycled or made into compost. Thirty-two percent of domestic rubbish is paper and cardboard. This means that nearly one-third of everything that is thrown away in the UK is paper! Nine million tonnes of paper and cardboard, or the equivalent to six trees, is consumed by each family each year. Less than half the paper used in the UK is recycled – 6 million tonnes of paper and board are used once and then discarded. This is a shocking waste of natural resources, and to halt this scandalous state of affairs, children and grown-ups should begin to take recycling very seriously indeed.
