Hyde Park

Hyde Park is already registered because of its heritage interest and importance. It is the largest of four Royal Parks that form a chain from the entrance of Kensington Palace and Green Park, past the main entrance to Buckingham Palace, in the capital of the United Kingdom.

The park was established by Henry VIII in 1536 when he took the land from Westminster Abbey and used it as a hunting ground. It opened to the public in 1637 and quickly became popular, particularly for May Day parades. Also the Great Exhibition of 1851 was held in the park, and because of that it owns the Crystal Palace, a monument with the greatest area of glass ever seen in a building at that time. With this construction, Britain showed their latest technology to the world.

Free speeches and demonstrations have been a key feature of Hyde Park in the 20th century. Many groups have all held their protests there, but nowadays it has become popular because it held some of the most significant concerts in rock: Queen, Elton John, R.E.M., U2 or Coldplay are still remembered for their performance at Hyde Park.
